- **United States (Healthy People 2030):** Aims to reduce adult cigarette smoking prevalence to 6.1%. The FDA has proposed capping nicotine levels in cigarettes to minimally or non-addictive levels.

### Methods Used to Achieve 2030 Goals:

- **Rising Legal Age:** Increasing the minimum age to purchase tobacco products annually, or increasing it permanently.
- **Product Regulation:** Capping nicotine levels to non-addictive levels and banning specific products like menthol cigarettes or disposable vapes.
- **Price Increases & Taxing:** Using high taxation to reduce demand.
- **Expanded Smoke-Free Zones:** Prohibiting smoking in public spaces, including terraces and parks.  World Health Organization (WHO) +5
